## The Lido needs your support

More than 40 years ago, the people of Chipping Norton ran a weekly lottery to raise the funds to build a swimming pool.

Now, over ten years after returning the pool to community control, the trustees of The Lido are promoting the lottery again in order to raise vital funds to keep the pool open for future generations.

The Lido plays an important role in the recreational and social life of the town but, with our only source of public funding a small grant from Chipping Norton Town Council, we also need to raise funds to help cover our running costs.

The Lottery is a way of raising some of these funds while also giving something back to our supporters.

#### How it works

To make things simple, subscriptions are paid by standing order on the first day of each month.

Prize money will be paid direct to the winners' bank accounts within five days of the draw's taking place. A list of the winners for the current month will be displayed at The Lido and on our website. A complete list of winners will be maintained by the trustees. In the interests of fairness, each draw will be attended by at least two trustees and one independent witness.

The Lido Lottery is open to anyone over the age of sixteen.

#### **Prizes**

The Lido Lottery will be drawn on the 10th day of each month, with prizes allocated as follows:

1st prize: 25% of subscriptions (£150 if 200 tickets are sold);

2nd prize: 15% of subscriptions (£90 if 200 tickets are sold);

3rd prize: 10% of subscriptions (£60 if 200 tickets are sold)

There is no minimum period for subscription. If at any time you wish to withdraw from the Lottery, you simply contact your bank and cancel your standing order.

### Other ways to support us

#### **Legacy Giving**

Leaving The Lido a gift in your will means that your money can continue to support the facility and secure it for future generations to enjoy.

Whether leaving a fixed sum or a share of your estate, there are a number of ways to remember us in your will.


